In addition, SIRS indexing is done by professionals utilizing Library of Congress subject headings. Many companies index their databases by computer, utilizing the number of times a word appears in an article. Computer indexing is often irrelevant. In contrast, SIRS indexing is so accurate and useful that it has become a standard for the industry.

SIRS research staff discusses and follows the continuity of current events, enduring issues and educational concepts. Each staff member adds a unique dimension, representing a variety of educational backgrounds and work experiences such as education, library science, journalism, political science, sociology, business, marketing and the humanities.
